NEW BUSINESS

Directors Update:

Tree 413: Aimee Petrosky discussed complaints on Tree 413 and the risk that it poses. She informed the Board of her discussions with other state level individuals in regards to the use of the public nuisance code, and their recommendation to use a code specific to businesses. Aimee explained how she was waiting on confirmation from town counsel to use that code and its ability to stand up in court if it were needed. Paul Federici stated that we should wait to send an order until we hear from town counsel.

Posting for new BOH:

Paul Federici discussed how he believes the appointment of the new Board of Health is the responsibility of the Town Council. Aimee agreed to discuss who is responsible for posting the vacancies, as well as whom the appointing authority is with Bob Peirent, Acting Town Manager, and report back to the Board of Health at the next meeting. Paul Federici will also bring it up at the next Town Council meeting. Aimee Petrosky updated Board on the feedback from MAHB that towns do not need to have a physician, and that members do not need to live in town. It was agreed by all that having the board members be East Longmeadow residents is best.

Motion:

Fats Oils and Grease application and fee:

Aimee Petrosky made recommendation to the Board to create a fee for application of Fats oils and grease discharge system at \$50.00, stating that by keeping it low, it will be consistent with other fees in town. Paul stated that the header should be changed on the application because

there is no longer a Board of Selectmen. Aimee stated she would change it. William Gorman proposed a motion to approve the Fat's oil's and grease application and fee as presented. Paul Federici moved the motion, and William Gorman seconded the motion out of necessity. **Motion passed 2-0.**

Request from Cornerstone Church

Motion:

William Gorman proposed a motion to approve a Temporary Food Service Permit for the Cornerstone Church of 15 Kibbe Road on Tuesday, August 2, 2016 from 5:30pm-8:00pm, at East Longmeadow High School in conjunction with national night out. Request from East Longmeadow Youth Football

Motion:

William Gorman proposed a motion to approve a Temporary Food Service Permit for the East Longmeadow Youth Football at East Longmeadow High School snack booth. Paul Federici moved the motion, and William Gorman seconded out of necessity. **Motion passed 2-0.**

Elmcrest Country Club

Motion:

William Gorman proposed a motion to approve a Temporary Food Service Permit for Elmcrest Country Club in conjunction with East Longmeadow Women's Invitational on July 14th, July 15th, and July 16th held at 105 Summersville Rd. Paul Federici moved the motion, and William Gorman seconded out of necessity. **Motion passed 2-0.**

Challenger Sports

William Gorman discussed previous compliance issues with this particular camp in the past. Aimee Petrosky informed the Board that there continue to be compliance issues.

Motion:

William Gorman proposed a motion to approve a Camp Permit for Challenger Sports pending the proper completion of application. Camp to be held on July 11- July 15th at the East Longmeadow High School. Paul Federici moved the motion, and William Gorman seconded out of necessity. **Motion passed 2-0.**

The next Board of Health meeting will be on July 21st at 3:00 P.M.

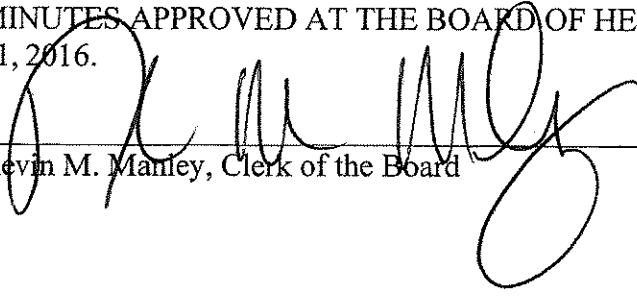
Motion:
